INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Unscrew the bulb.
- Insert 3x AA alkaline batteries (+) positive side up.
 NOTE: Do not force the battery into the candlestick.
 Guide the battery past the metal contact at the top of the candlestick, and then it should drop with ease.
 IMPORTANT BATTERY INFO:

Use only new, fully charged alkaline batteries. Do not mix new and old batteries. Lithium, rechargeable, and heavy duty batteries are not recommended because battery life will be significantly reduced when compared to alkaline.

- 3. Replace bulb.
- Candle will turn on once the bulb is fully screwed in.
 (Default setting is twinkling action)
- If bulb is removed to replace batteries, candle will return to default setting.
- 4. Use remote to change the preferred settings
- ON/OFF | Steady/Twinkle | Length of Timer

HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT:

Candle height has two positions (10.5" and 9")

- Candle arrives in 9" height
- To adjust to 10.5" taller position, remove the rubber ring located at the base of the candlestick. Slide the candlestick.up and out of the base.

Replace rubber ring on candlestick.

Push candlestick into

top portion of the base until secure.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION:

Remote battery included. Remove tab before use. Battery

replacement use CR2025 battery.

ON - On for 24 hours

OFF - Manual turn everything off

Tw - Switch to Twinkle function

St - Switch to Steady on function

CARE:

- Remove alkaline batteries from candlestick when not in use. Batteries left in the candle when not in use can leak and cause corrosion.
- Remove alkaline batteries when the candle dims.

- Store in a temperature controlled environment with normal humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

1. Candle Will Not Light

- Be sure to check the orientation of the batteries. Batteries should all be (+) positive side up.

2. Timer Seems to be Incorrect (Not Working)

- The timer may reset because the candle is moved abruptly, dropped, or tilted. If you suspect this may have happened please reset timer by turning unit OFF with the remote (or by removing the batteries) and reset timer with the remote. Place gently in desired position on window sill. Timer will also reset if batteries are removed.

3. Light Appears Dim

- Make sure that batteries are new and fully charged.
 Do not mix old and new batteries. The candle should remain close to full brightness for about 30 days (with 6 hour timer setting).
- One or more batteries facing the wrong direction (all should be (+) positive side up).
