Battery Operated Window Candle—VT-R1661 Series


(For Indoor Use Only)

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Remove candlestick from the decorative base.
- 2. Un-screw the bottom gripper cap of the candlestick by turning counterclockwise.
- 3. Insert three AA alkaline batteries (+) positive contact first into the candlestick. Be sure that (+) and (-) terminals on each battery match the (+) and (-) contacts shown in the diagram.

CAUTION: Do not mix new and old batteries. Do not mix alkaline and standard (carbon-zinc) or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.

NOTE: Lithium, rechargeable, and heavy-duty batteries will have significantly reduced battery life compared life compared to alkaline.



- 4. Screw the bottom cap back into the candlestick by turning clockwise. **NOTE:** Candle will now be on. If left on, the candle will turn off automatically after six hours and turn back on again the next day at the same time. The timer cycle will be interrupted when replacing the batteries.
- 5. Candle can be turned off by un-screwing the bottom cap several turns, or by pressing "OFF" on remote.
- 6. Push gripper base straight into candlestick holder so that it is securely held.

REMOTE CONTROL OPERATION:

- 1. Remote battery included. Remove tab before use. For battery replacement use CR2025 battery. Default settings are 6 hour ON/18 hour OFF with flicker light mode.
- 2. Point remote towards candlestick.
 - Auto Timer: Select desired timer setting
 4, 6, 8, 12 ON and balance of 24 hours off. Repeats daily. NOTE: Unscrewing the cap on the candlestick will reset candlestick to default settings.
 Mode: Select flicker or no flicker.



ON/OFF: Pressing the "ON" and "OFF"

buttons will require resetting the timer.

NOTE: Increasing length of timer will decrease battery life (Candlestick battery life is approximately 70 days with 6 hour ON default timer).

CARE:

- Remove batteries from candlestick when not in use. Batteries left in the candle when not in use can leak and cause corrosion.
- Lithium battery in remote may be left in remote while in storage.
- Replace batteries when the candle dims.
- Dispose of used batteries responsibly.
- Clean with a non-abrasive cleaner.
- Store in a temperature controlled environment with normal humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING:

1. Candle Will Not Light

- Be sure to check the placement of the batteries. Please reference the battery installation portion of instructions.

2. Timer & Flicker/Steady Function Issues

- Reference remote control portion of instructions first.
- The timer may reset because the candle is moved abruptly, dropped, or tilted. If you suspect this happened please make sure the battery cap is fully tightened up. Then reset the timer and set it gently in position.

3. Light Appears Dim

- Batteries may need to be replaced. Do not mix old and new batteries. The candle should remain close to full brightness for about 70 days on default settings (6 hours ON/18 hours OFF).
